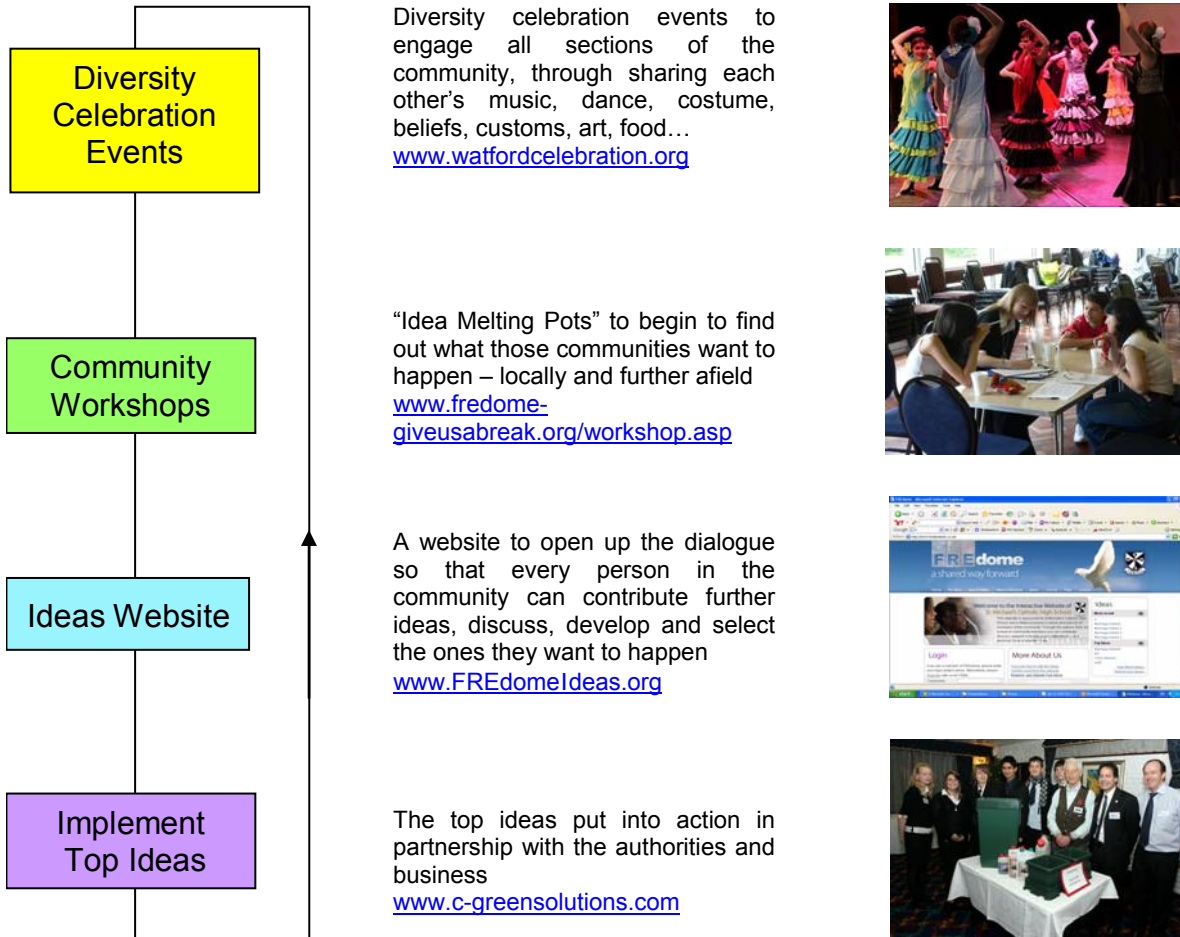


A shared way forward

The aim of FREdome is to connect the collective goodwill and ingenuity of people in the community to what happens in society, for the sake of ourselves, our children and future generations.

Our work consists of supporting four types of activity:



The first programme of this type was launched in Watford, Herts:

1. The multicultural **event** was particularly successful, with around 89 organisations and 2,500 people in attendance.
2. At the **workshops** ("idea melting pots") people of different cultures and beliefs, in the arts, voluntary, commercial & public sectors worked together on sparking and developing their creative, practical and inspirational ideas.
3. The interactive, ideas **website** has been funded by St Michael's Catholic High School & Specialist Humanities College.
4. The flagship **idea** to emerge from the project is for young people (especially the vulnerable) to grow high-yield, high-nutrition vegetables in sea nutrients, for their school canteens and the local community. They will move towards growing marine algae in sea nutrients on land, as a route to tackling climate change, the energy crisis, starvation and disease resulting from poor diets – through rapid carbon capture, and producing valuable carbon-based resources, such as fuels, food, fertilisers (to reforest deserts and wastelands), fabrics, medicines and other materials...

FREdome believes that this proven model has tremendous potential to be rolled out to help integrate and support communities across the UK and beyond.

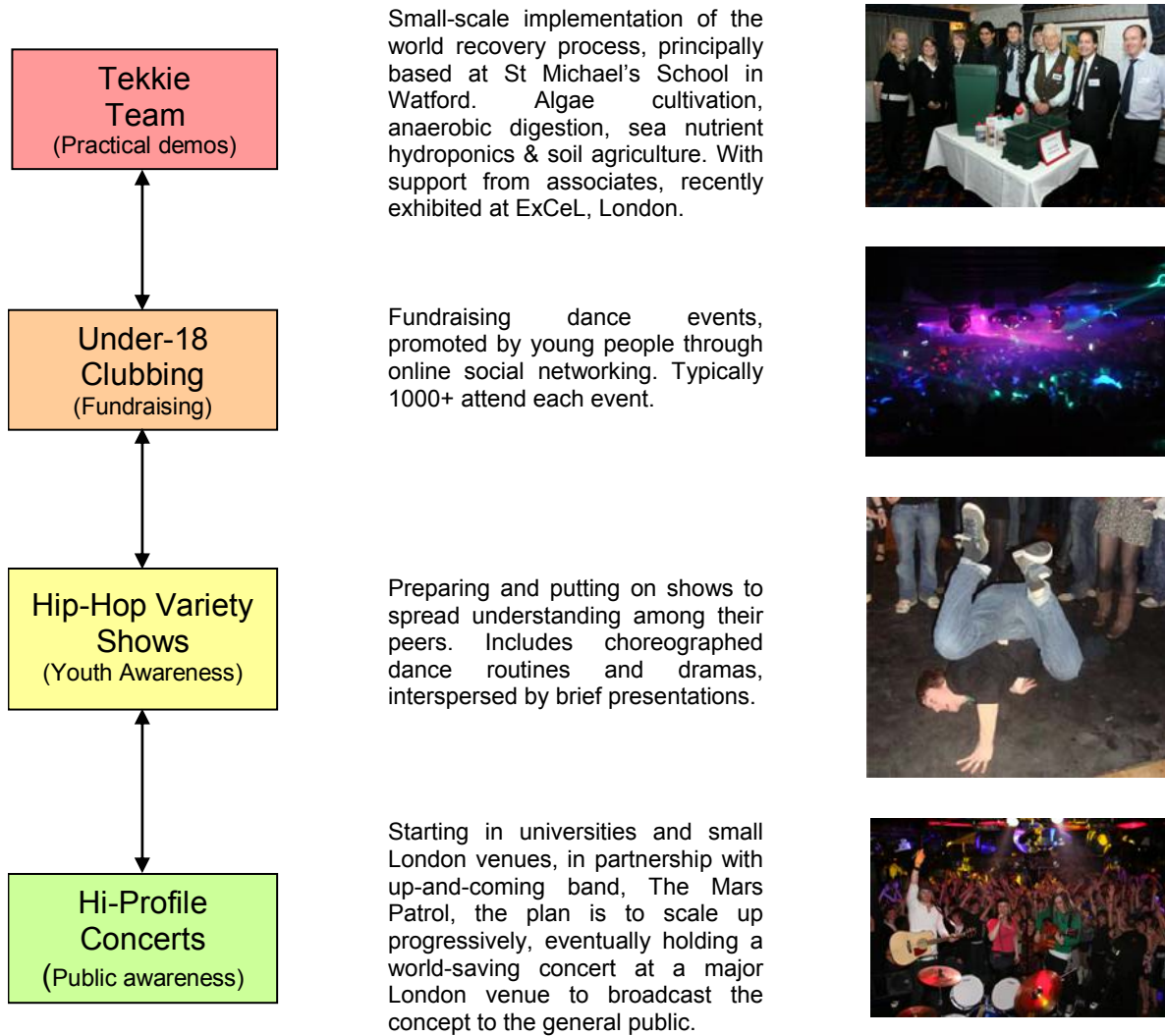

Youth Encouraging Adults

Our young supporters of FREdome's first, flagship project (C-Green Solutions) have organised themselves into four main groups:

With the help of the fastest-growing marine algae we can turn solar energy, excess CO₂, sea nutrients and waste back into the very things that the world is running out of, creating a plentiful planet and restoring the global economy in the process.
